On June 3, 2017, the Little Free Library was dedicated to Newtown's Boundless Garden. The Little Free Library was custom-designed and constructed by a very talented, longtime neighbor who prefers to remain anonymous. About the design he said, "An important factor was to allow room for large children's books, with two adjustable shelves for regular-sized books. The door was designed to be inviting to children and arouse their curiosity about the adventures of reading. The door panel is Plexiglas engraved with an image of the west door to the mines of Moria (from Tolkien's *Lord of the Rings*) and is back-lit with RGB LEDs (solar and battery powered, motion activated). The door frame is walnut carved with Celtic designs." It is indeed a very special library!

Little Free Libraries are popping up in neighborhoods all over the country. The motto **Take a Book, Leave a Book** applies to books for all ages from children to adults.
